



# Study Abroad Photo Contest

Now that the Study Abroad offices have moved to the front of King Hall, we're looking for a few great photographs from Guilford-led and Guilford-affiliated programs to decorate wall space.

We're especially interested in photographs from the following programs: Brunnenburg, China, Ghana, Guadalajara, Japan, London, Munich, Paris, and Siena. We welcome photos from other Guilford-affiliated programs as well.

## **Eligibility:**

The contest is open to all current Guilford students who have studied or are studying abroad this semester on a Guilford-led or -affiliated program, or recent graduates (2008 or 2009) who have completed one of these programs.

## **Instructions:**

- You may submit a maximum of 5 color or black and white photographs in high-quality digital format. Ideally, the image should be at least 1400 pixels along its shortest dimension. We need to be able to blow them up to small poster size, approximately 18 x 24.
- In an e-mail or note accompanying your entry, please be certain to identify the program; any Guilford students, faculty, or leaders; and important landmarks, buildings, or other items shown in the photograph.
- Include your full name, home city & state, major(s) & minor(s), and year of graduation (actual or anticipated).
- Photographs should depict regular activities and places associated with the program, though they don't have to show famous landmarks (like the Eiffel Tower or the slave castle in Cape Coast).
- Images including students would be great, but posed group shots are less likely to work well.

Winning photos will be re-sized, mounted, and hung on the wall in the front of King. Labels identifying the photographer and items in the photo will be included.
