Guilford's study abroad programs take students around the globe, where they play an active role in their host communities. Each Guilford semester abroad has its own unique academic character and lifestyle, allowing students a great deal of choice in location and purpose. Choose from opportunities to assist in community development projects in Cape Coast, Ghana, or Guadalajara, Mexico, to internship experience in bustling multicultural cities like London, to independent environmental science study in the Turks and Caicos Islands--whether you major in the sciences, religious studies, business, sociology/anthropology, theatre studies, English, economics, sport management, education, or any other field, Guilford has a program that will fit your needs.

Get Credit

All Guilford-led and -affiliated programs are approved for Guilford credit. Most courses carry four credits and many fulfill general education or major requirements. Whether you want to study abroad in order to sharpen your language skills, fulfill major requirements, or learn new things in a certain place, Guilford has an option for you.

Paying for your trip

Guilford is committed to making study abroad affordable, so students who participate in Guilford-led or -affiliated programs have access to all their financial aid. Most Guilford-led programs cost the same as an on-campus semester plus airfare (excluding personal items like additional travel and entertainment expenses); some affiliated programs necessitate a surcharge. Some additional scholarship money for travel is available through the Board of Visitors Scholarship program.
