Head Coach Tom Palombo

Coach Palombo has been a head collegiate basketball coach for 19 years, compiling a 355-158 mark that includes eight trips to the NCAA Tournament. Last season, the Quakers posted a 26-6 record and advanced to the NCAA Division III Final Four for the first time in school history. Guilford finished third in the nation by defeating Franklin & Marshall to go 5-1 in the NCAA Tournament. Prior to his arrival at Guilford, Palombo served as the head men's coach at Defiance College in Ohio for six years. Prior to becoming the men's coach at Defiance College, Palombo coached the women's team to a 78-7 mark, making three consecutive NCAA appearances and two straight Elite Eight finishes. His teams led the nation in scoring and attendance twice and Palombo was named the National Coach of the Year in 1996. Coach Palombo's teams have been noted for their offensive scoring ability and their relentless defensive attack.

Associate Head Coach Matt Parke

Coach Parke completed his third season at Guilford College. He came to Guilford after serving on Dave Odom's staff at the University of South Carolina as a graduate assistant coach. While earning his master's degree in business administration, Parke helped South Carolina to a 2004 NCAA Tournament berth and the 2005 National Invitational Tournament title. He moved to the University of Alabama for 2005-06 and served as the director of basketball operations on coach Mark Gottfried's staff for the NCAA Tournament-bound Crimson Tide.

The camp staff will also include the finest available college players and high school coaches.

This year's camp is open to boys and girls. Campers will be divided according to age and ability.

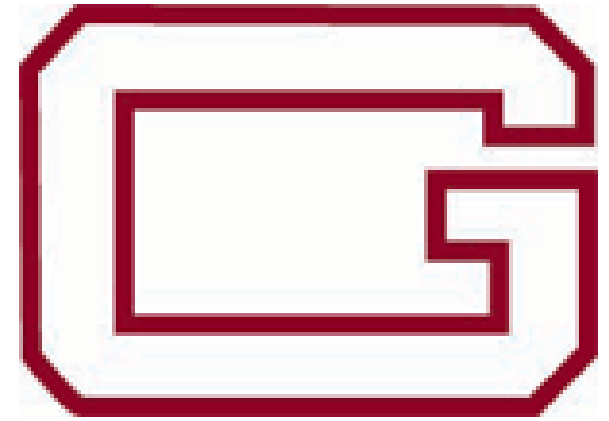
