

H1N1 (Nasal Spray) Vaccine Available

The H1N1 Influenza (**Live, Attenuated-Nasal Spray**) Vaccine is now available at the Student Health Center. There is no cost for any student/faculty/staff member who would like to receive the vaccine.

We will begin administering the vaccine on Tuesday, November 3rd and will continue with the following schedule until our supply is depleted:

Tuesdays – 1:00pm - 4:00pm

Wednesdays – 9:00am - 12:00 noon

Thursdays – 1:00 – 4:00pm

Note: These are the only times we will be able to administer the vaccine.

Being as we are reliant on the State of NC for our vaccine supply, we were sent the nasal spray version of the vaccine; we are not able to offer the inactivated (shot) form of the vaccine at this time and are not aware of a local resource for the inactivated vaccine.

If you have any of the following medical circumstances, you should **not** take this vaccine:

- pregnancy
- heart or kidney disease
- diabetes
- asthma
- weakened immune system or family member with this illness
- muscle or nerve disorders (cerebral palsy)
- allergy to eggs
- over 49 years of age
- currently sick
