GUILFORD BASKETBALL ROUNDUP - JANUARY 27, 2004

Women's Home Streak at 29

Guilford's women's basketball team added to its school-record 29-game home winning streak with two wins last week. The Quakers made their first appearance in the Ragan-Brown Field House in over six weeks a successful one with a 64-50 triumph over Roanoke. The Maroons were the last team to beat the Quakers when they dealt Guilford a 56-55 loss February 13, 2001. Guilford has won 48 of its last 50 home games, dating to 1999.

Defense Clamps Down

The Quakers averaged 17 steals per game in their two wins last week. Led by sophomore **Jennifer King's (Reidsville, NC)** season-high four steals, Guilford made a season-high 18 thefts against Roanoke, leading to 26 Maroons' turnovers and 25 Guilford points.

Junior **Kelly Burger (Toms River, NJ)** made three steals and the team had 16 thefts three days later against Hollins. Guilford held Hollins to just 28 points, the sixth-fewest points allowed in Guilford history. Hollins was also the opponent the last time the Quakers kept an opponent under 30 points. Guilford knocked off Hollins, 57-27, February 14, 2002. Hollins shot just 24.4 percent from the floor against Guilford last Saturday, including four of 22 (18.2%) in the second half.

Robertson Nears Three-Point Mark

Senior guard **A.J. Robertson (Eden, NC)** started the week 10 three-pointers shy of breaking the Quakers' career record of 103 set by **Bari Nixon '97**. Robertson, who missed Saturday's game with an injury, broke **Arden Miller's '01** career three-point attempts record earlier this year. Robertson is 94 for 290 (32.4%) from beyond the arc in 95 career contests. She started the week ranked third among the Old Dominion Athletic Conference's (ODAC) three-pointers per game leaders (2.0).

Moving Up, Getting Tough

Guilford's men's basketball team has won four straight matches and eight of its last 10 games to secure a share of fourth place in the ODAC standings. The Quakers' 10-7 record is the program's best 17-game mark in its Division III history and its best since 1982-83.

The team plays its next four games against teams with better or equal league records. The Quakers visit Virginia Wesleyan Saturday, followed by a visit to Randolph-Macon. Virginia Wesleyan just slipped out of the D3hoops.com Division III national rankings for the first time in a few weeks, while Randolph-Macon moved up to number four this week. Guilford returns home next Wednesday (2/4) to play eighth-ranked Hampden-Sydney. Bridgewater, which shares fourth-place with Guilford, comes to Greensboro February 7.

Clarke Leads the Way

Senior forward **Jevon Clarke (Apex, NC)** starts the week ranked ninth among the ODAC's scoring leaders. Guilford boasts an 8-1 record when Clarke tops the team's scorers. He needs 75 points to reach 1,000 for his career and would be the 20th Quakers' men's basketball player to reach the 1,000-career point plateau.
