In lieu of standardized test scores, you may submit an academic portfolio that will include, but is not limited to, 3 - 5 writing samples (at least one should be a graded expository written work) and if available jr/sr year reading lists, a short answer response regarding your decision to submit a portfolio. In addition, students are responsible for scheduling an interview with a member of the admission staff or with a Guilford College alum. Withholding SAT I or ACT scores will not prejudice your chances for admission.

NOTE: Students who opt to apply using standardized test scores are also welcome to submit personal portfolios to supplement their applications, if they so desire.
