Former Guilford College students who wish to re-enroll must gain approval from the Office of Admission. Students who were academically separated from Guilford College must also receive approval from the Associate Academic Dean. This Application for Readmission will be forwarded to the Academic Dean’s Office for this approval, if necessary. Please be aware that all prior balances must be cleared before a student will be readmitted to the college.

Applications received (and complete) by **October 15** for **spring semester** will be processed and a decision available by November 1. Applications received after October 15 will receive a decision within 4 weeks. No applications for **spring semester** will be accepted after **November 15**.

Applications received (and complete) by **March 15** for **fall or summer semesters** will be processed and a decision available by April 1. Applications received after March 15 will receive a decision within 4 weeks. No applications for **summer semester** will be accepted after **April 1**. No applications for **fall semester** will be accepted after **July 1**.
