Fall Elections for Senators

Responsibilities of Newly Elected Senators

Within 3 weeks of becoming a Senator, that Senator must hold a Meet & Greet for his or her constituents. This must be in a public space and may be no less than 2 hours time. After Fall Elections, the Secretary and the Communications Committee may elect a day for a full Senate Meet & Greet. In the event of this, all currently elected officials must attend this day or, with reason, ask to hold their own on a different day.

Campaign Rules and Regulations:

Each ticket shall be allowed 30 8 ½" x 11" sheets of paper. The sheets may have writing on both sides and be cut into smaller pieces. The sheets may be placed around campus in compliance with the regular rules for posting of the College. The Student Organization Card (found at the info desk) may be used to pay for the cost printing/copying.

Ads may not be taken out in The Guilfordian or any other newspapers..

No other video or multimedia displays are permitted.

Uses of the telephone voice mail distribution system to campaign (mass/campus-wide voice mail), campus Electronic Mail system, and regular campus mail are prohibited.

Candidates are responsible for removal and disposal of campaign materials.

Severe violations of any Campaign rule may warrant disqualification. Elections Committee will hold an inquiry pertaining to reported infractions of Campaign Rules, pursuant to the section on appeals process.
