

Overloads Policy

UPDATED VERSION (July 2025)

Students must submit a petition to the registrar requesting permission to overload under the following circumstances: The student wishes to take more than

- 18 credits in a regular semester (fall/spring)
- 16 total credits in summer school
- 12 credits during the eight-week summer term
- 8 credits during a four-week summer term

Exception: Music students taking MUS 270 courses with course fees.

Advisor approval is required for overload requests by students with a cumulative GPA below 3.25. Students requesting over 20 credits must be approved by the Associate Academic Dean (<u>link to updated Petition form</u>). Charges for overloads are assessed per credit hour (See Tuition and Fees for more information).

h. Credit Overloads

No student may be registered to take more than four credits of coursework in any three-week session. Students can consult with the Associate Academic Deans for permission to combine coursework at other institutions with an experience in the three-week session.

Students must submit a petition to the registrar requesting permission to overload under the following circumstances:

The student wishes to take more than

- 14 credits in a fourteen-week session
- 6 credits in summer school
- 12 credits during the eight-week summer term
- 8 credits during a four weeks summer term

Please note that no overload petitions for the 14-week session will be approved without students being registered for a course in the corresponding 3-week session.
