

Greater Greensboro Consortium Information for Guilford College Students

Your consortium coursework will be listed on your Guilford College registration, but you must also register at the host institution to receive credit for the course(s). All charges will be assessed by Guilford College and are payable to Guilford College Office of Student Accounts, 5800 West Friendly Avenue, Greensboro, NC 27410.

Information for students enrolled in consortium courses

- You must be enrolled for as many or more credits at Guilford College than you are at the consortium institution.
- All consortium credits apply toward your enrollment status at Guilford College. This means consortium coursework affects your grade point average and number of credits earned.
- You must have a cumulative gpa of 2.00 or higher to take consortium courses
- The consortium operates during the fall and spring semesters only.
- Rules, regulations, and deadlines in effect on the host campus apply to all consortium students taking courses on that campus.
- If you are a senior in your last semester before graduation, please note that the host school is under no obligation to report your consortium grades early.

Instructions for Guilford College students taking consortium coursework elsewhere

- **Take** your **approved** consortium registration form to the Registrar's Office at your host campus during their add period (see dates below).
- There is no guarantee that space will be available in your chosen course. If you are **unable to register for the course**, you must notify the Guilford College Registrar's Office so that the course will be removed from your record.
- If you **drop a consortium course**, process the drop in the Registrar's Office at the host campus. You must also notify the Guilford College Registrar's Office so that the course will be removed from your record.
- **Consortium parking decals** may be obtained from the Guilford College Security Office

Your Host Campus may require your unofficial transcript and/or course schedule.
